It is with much sadness and regret that we must announce the cancellation of the 2021 IRSA Marblehead and 10r Class World Championships, scheduled to be hosted at West Kirby over June 2021, due to the ongoing uncertainty connected with the Covid 19 pandemic.

Unfortunately, as I am sure everyone knows, this pandemic continues to affect all of us in our daily lives and is not offering signs of going away anytime soon. In the UK, we are now again seeing many localised lockdowns as we head towards a second spike of infections. It is felt across all parties connected to make the event happen, that we just cannot take the chance of going ahead with the race and then incur another lockdown situation or added restrictions imposed on travelling skippers.

It is our team's belief that we have a duty of care to both classes and their respective owners in making sure to retain the integrity of both World Championships. We feel that should skippers not be in a position to travel openly without restrictions or added health concerns, that the very nature of a successful event, worthy of its title would be compromised.
